Igbo Culture & Terms



Mmanwu:

Mmanwu are colorful Igbo Masquerades that represent spirits, dieties and sometimes even deceased relatives. In the past Mmanwu were used as a means to maintain peace and order by loudly exposing and shaming those who engaged in bad behavior. Kind of like Twitter now- ha! Post-colonization they have become more of a means to entertain during special events and are often accompanied by music and traditional dancers.

"Chineke Meh!":

Chi in Igbo represents the creator as well as your personal spirit. The word *Chineke* means "high God". Chineke Meh means... "Oh my God!"

Juju:

Juju is essentially "magic" based around rituals. Juju has a more negative connotation in modern day Nigeria.
